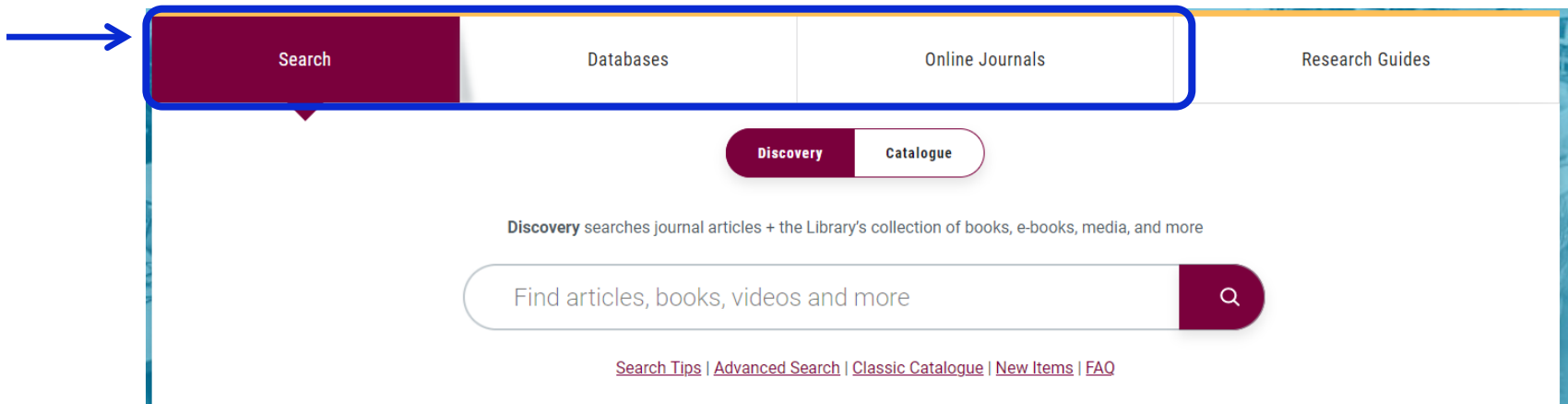

**Discovery** simultaneously searches McMaster's **library catalogue**

**PLUS**

the contents of several **subscription databases & open access sites** such as JSTOR and HathiTrust.

**Results can be refined** by a variety of criteria in the left column (e.g. format, language, date of publication, etc.)

Discovery and Catalogue can include some of the same format types (i.e., books, videos, etc.), but **only Discovery includes articles.**

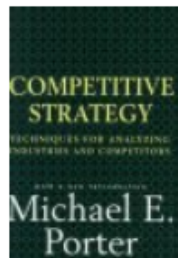


# Scan and Send



## Print Collections at University Library

- Select the **scan** button in the **detailed Catalogue** record and include the desired pages in resulting form.

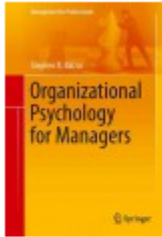

# Interlibrary Loan (I.L.L.)

## Get Books & Articles from Other Libraries

- If a book or article is *not held* at McMaster, use [RACER](#) (**R**apid **A**ccess to **C**ollections by **E**lectronic **R**equesting) to submit I.L.L. requests (link on home page) **NOTE:** Requires one time [registration](#).
- Regular service is **FREE** of charge.
- **Books:** Books will be delivered to McMaster. **Pick up** and return I.L.L. books at the Mills Library Service Desk (1<sup>st</sup> floor). **NOTE:** I.L.L. books not eligible for mail service.
- **Articles:** I.L.L. articles will be delivered to you online. Takes **2-5 days (or longer)** for materials to arrive.
- **Notified by email** when items are available

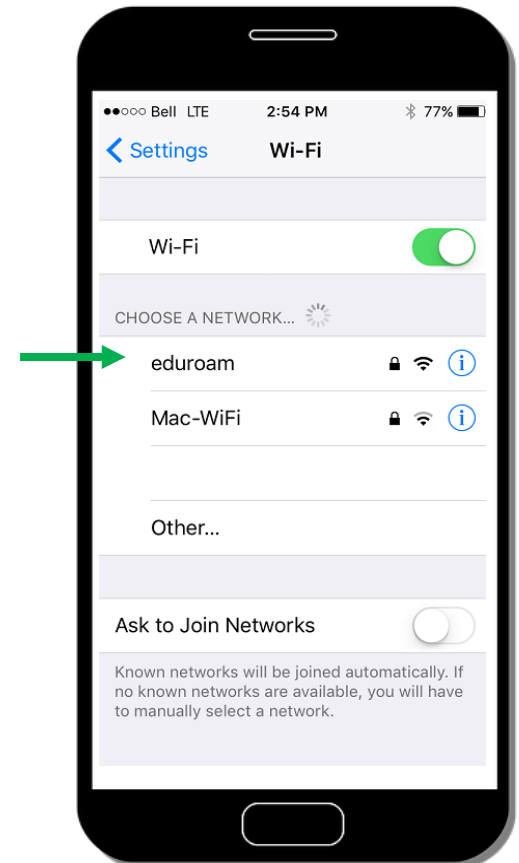
## Borrowing Books In Person @ other University Libraries

- Use a [Reciprocal Borrower Card](#) to borrow books from other institutions in Canada for free
  - **EXCEPTION: University of Toronto** Libraries charge reciprocal borrowers a fee of \$300 for a borrower card. McMaster University Library will subsidize \$250 towards the cost of these cards, for **graduate students only**. Complete this [application form](#).
- Some material exclusions (e.g., reserves, reference) and borrowing limitations (shorter loan period, limit on # of items borrowed) apply

# Eduroam (Education Roaming)

- Provides **secure, free, Wi-Fi roaming service** to McMaster students, faculty & staff when visiting **research & education institutions anywhere in the world.**

## Business Journal Rankings

-  **ABDC Journal Quality List** (ABDC - Australian Business Deans Council)  
Established in 2007, the list is used as a guide by business schools around the world to assess the quality of the journals in which faculty members' research is published.
-  **Academic Journal Guide (or AJG)** - Free registration required (CABS - Chartered Association of Business Schools, United Kingdom)  
Published every three years, the AJG is a guide to the range, subject matter and relative quality of journals in which business and management academics publish their research. The latest guide (2018) includes a total of 1,582 journals. Search for specific journals by name or ISSN number, or browse by field. Click on the column headings to sort the tables by different data sets.
-  **DSB 45 Journals List**  
A list of 45 journals identified by McMaster University's DeGroote School of Business (DSB).

## Business Theses at McMaster

- This guide lists all the PhD theses (or dissertations) in Business Administration completed at the **DeGroote School of Business** at **McMaster University** from 1984 to the present (i.e., 152 titles).
- The theses are organized into six areas of study: Accounting & Finance, Health Management, Information Systems, Management of Organizational Behaviour & Human Resources, Management Science, and Marketing.
