Borrowing Physical Materials from McMaster Libraries



- Library Card: McMaster Student ID card
- Loan Period:
 - 120 days (University Library) NEW
 - 2 weeks (Health Sciences Library)
- Renewals: All books can be renewed (unless they have been recalled).
 Select <u>My Library Account</u> on Library home page. Login with the **14 digit** barcode on your McMaster ID card and a numeric PIN code (at least 4 digits).



Accessing e-Collections at McMaster Libraries

- Your MacID gives you access to all the Library's online resources (e-books, e-journals, databases, etc.) 24/7, anywhere in the world!
- Connect to our online resources via the Library's website – <u>https://library.mcmaster.ca</u>
- When prompted, login with your MacID

the contents of several subscription databases & open access sites such as JSTOR and HathiTrust.

Results can be refined by a variety of criteria in the left column (e.g. format, language, date of publication, etc.)

Discovery and Catalogue can include some of the same format types (i.e., books, videos, etc.), but only Discovery includes articles.

Print Books at the University Library

 If an item you want has a Request it button in <u>Discovery /</u> <u>Catalogue</u>, click the button and login to your Library Account with your McMaster ID barcode and PIN..





- Requesting applies to *most* items whose status is **Available**. Archives and other rare materials are typically excluded.
- You will be notified by email when the requested item is ready. The item can be picked-up in person or <u>sent by mail via</u> <u>Canada Post</u> – NEW (free service, Canadian addresses only).

Print Books at McMaster Libraries

• In <u>Discovery/Catalogue</u>, use the **Request It** button to recall items already checked out by another user.

- Recalls: If another user has *requested* a book you have checked out, you will get an email requesting that the book be returned by a <u>new due date</u>.
- You will be **notified by email** when the item has been recalled and is ready for you (pick-up or mail).



Scan and Send

Print Collections at University Library



- Use for articles and book chapters only available in print (i.e., not online)
- Select the scan button in the detailed <u>Catalogue</u> record and include the desired pages in resulting form.



 Requested item will be delivered by email within 48 (or more) hours (M-F).

Get Books & Articles from Other Libraries

- If a book or article is <u>not held</u> at McMaster, use <u>RACER</u> (Rapid Access to Collections by Electronic Requesting) to submit I.L.L. requests (link on home page) NOTE: Requires one time <u>registration</u>.
- Regular service is **FREE** of charge.
- Books: Books will be delivered to McMaster. Pick up and return I.L.L. books at the Mills Library Service Desk (1st floor). NOTE: I.L.L. books not eligible for mail service.
- Articles: I.L.L. articles will be delivered to you online. Takes 2-5 days (or longer) for materials to arrive. How library
- Notified by email when items are available

Borrowing Books <u>In Person</u> @ <u>other</u> University Libraries

- Use a <u>Reciprocal Borrower Card</u> to borrow books from other institutions in Canada for free
 - EXCEPTION: University of Toronto Libraries charge reciprocal borrowers a fee of \$300 for a borrower card. McMaster University Library will subsidize \$250 towards the cost of these cards, for graduate students only. Complete this application form.
- Some material exclusions (e.g., reserves, reference) and borrowing limitations (shorter loan period, limit on # of items borrowed) apply
- For full details on program, read the <u>Canadian</u> <u>University Reciprocal Borrowing Agreement</u> <u>(CURBA)</u> and visit the reciprocal institution's website for specific policies

Eduroam (Education Roaming)

- Provides secure, free, Wi-Fi roaming service to McMaster students, faculty & staff when visiting research & education institutions anywhere in the world.
- Open your device and log into the eduroam network of a <u>participating</u> <u>institution</u> with your MacID and the realm identifier @mcmaster.ca (e.g., janedoe@mcmaster.ca)
- Access to another institution's licensed online resources will likely be restricted







Data Services & Support Mills Library, 1st floor

- have access to a wide assortment of digital numeric research data files (i.e., microdata or raw data)
- collection covers a broad range of subject areas with an emphasis on Social Sciences, Health Sciences, Business & Economics
- wherever possible, access to data is provided through self-serve web interfaces such as <u>odesi</u> & <u>ICPSR</u>
- consult with Data Specialist, <u>Vivek Jadon</u>, in <u>Maps/Data/GIS</u>

Research Data Management (RDM) is the active organization and maintenance of data throughout its lifecycle--from collection to interpretation, dissemination, long-term preservation, and reuse. McMaster RDM experts are available to consult on and assist with a variety of research data management including:

- General consulting on data management needs
- Assisting researchers in creating Data Management Plans and in using the Portage Network DMP Assistant tool;
- · Advising on issues related to research data storage and backup;
- Providing guidance on creating data documentation and metadata;
- Facilitating with data sharing-whether by consulting on prospective discipline-specific data repositories, or assisting
 with data deposit to general repositories such as McMaster Dataverse and the Federated Research Data Repository.
